

**Q: Where and when is the Yu-Gi-Oh! Common Box Games Championship?**

The event will be held at the Edmonton Expo Centre during Game Con Canada, June 20. Start time for round 1 will be 10:00AM.

**Q: What is the attendance capacity for the event?**

The capacity for the event will be max 52.

**Q: How do I enter the Yu-Gi-Oh! Common Box Games Championship ?**

Duelists will need a ticket for the Game Con Event and for the tournament.

**Q: What are the prizes for the Yu-Gi-Oh! Common Box Games Championship?**

In addition to the five (5) booster packs each Duelist receives upon entering the tournament, prize distribution will be as follows:

1st Place:

- Yu-Gi-Oh! Figurine Statue
- Yu-Gi-Oh! 6 Assorted Boxes from Recent Sets or \$300 store credit
- 1 Sealed OTS Box (TBD)
- Playmat

2nd Place:

- 1 Sealed OTS Box (TBD)
- 3 Sealed Boxes (TBD)
- Playmat

3rd-4th Place:

- 10 OTS Packs (TBD)
- 2 Sealed Box (TBD)
- Playmat

5-8th Place:

- 10 Packs OTS (TBD)
- 12 additional Packs Sealed (TBD)

9-16th Place:

- 5 Packs OTS (TBD)
- 8 additional Packs Sealed (TBD)

**Q: What is the format for the Yu-Gi-Oh! Common Box Games Championship?**

The **Yu-Gi-Oh! Common Box Games Championship** is a Constructed event, which means each Duelist must have his or her own Deck to compete. Decks must be constructed according to the latest Advanced Format guidelines. You can find the most recent Forbidden & Limited List and the date the list went into effect at <https://www.yugioh-card.com/en/limited/>.

The **Yu-Gi-Oh! Common Box Games Championship** will be using Swiss Format, which means all Duelists will play a set number of rounds determined by the number of Duelists enrolled in the tournament. Duelists are not eliminated during the event.

**Q: Will I need to complete and turn in a Deck List?**

Yes. All Duelists participating must turn in a completed Deck List to participate. Please check with the Tournament Organizer for additional information regarding the Deck List collection process.

Duelists can download the official KDE-US Deck List at [https://www.yugioh-card.com/en/downloads/forms/KDE\\_DeckList.pdf](https://www.yugioh-card.com/en/downloads/forms/KDE_DeckList.pdf). This is an editable PDF, so you will be able to type the card names in this form, which should

help

as your Deck List needs to be legible and complete – write the name of each card in full, and write down how many copies you have in your Deck.

**Q: Can I use OCG cards in my Deck?**

No. Cards printed for Asian markets are not legal for play in TCG tournaments.

Any card with the TCG logo on the back of the card is legal for play in TCG territories. You can tell the difference between a TCG card and an OCG card by checking the logo on the back of the card. This does include cards printed in Japanese, Korean, or Simplified Chinese that have the TCG logo on the back of the card. Any card with the OCG logo on the back of the card is not legal for play in TCG Territories.

**Q: What will I need to bring?**

You should bring a tournament-legal Deck as described above, along with any tournament supplies you will need, such as paper and pen to track Life Points, dice or counters if you are using cards which require them, extra sleeves to replace any that become damaged, and so forth. If you have a CARD GAME ID number, you should bring your number. You'll also need the entry fee for the tournament, as well as money for your incidentals (food, drink, Public Events, etc.)
